

## Human Relations Area Files

Human Relations Area Files, Inc. (HRAF) is an internationally recognized organization in the field of cultural anthropology. Established as a not-for-profit membership consortium of universities, colleges and research institutions, HRAF's mission is to provide information that facilitates the cross-cultural study of human behavior, society and culture. HRAF grew out of work in the 1930s by behavioral scientists at the Yale University Institute of Human Relations who began development of a classification scheme for cultural information by subject. The Human Relations Area Files was incorporated in 1949 with Harvard University, the University of Oklahoma, the University of Pennsylvania, the University of Washington and Yale University as its founding members. These five were joined within the year by the University of Chicago, the University of North Carolina and the University of Southern California. Some 300 colleges, universities, libraries, museums and research institutions in the United States and 25 other countries are now Associate or Sponsoring Members.

HRAF is a financially independent research agency of Yale University in New Haven, Connecticut. Since World War II, the growing concern of students, scholars and the general public around the world to understand ethnic conflict, cultural diversity and global problems has generated a demand for educational and research programs emphasizing the worldwide, comparative study of human behavior and society. The development of cross-cultural and area studies requires an extensive body of readily available organized cultural information. Scattered among myriad journals, dissertations and fieldwork studies and across numerous disciplines, conventional sources of such information are often inaccessible, expensive and difficult to utilize effectively. The HRAF collections are specifically designed to lessen these barriers to cross-cultural research.

*Only members of HRAF can acquire access to HRAF collections. Thus individuals or institutions (colleges, universities, public libraries, museums, high schools, etc.) must first become members of the HRAF consortium before they can acquire microfiche. All applicants must be approved by the Board of HRAF. However, virtually all applicants are accepted.*

# Ethnography

## Aborigines' Protection Society

1837 - 1909

Founded in 1837, the Aborigines' Protection Society published tracts, pamphlets and a journal titled *The Colonial Intelligencer* or *Aborigine's Friend*. The Society continued until 1909, when it merged with the Anti-Slavery Society. All volumes published by the Aborigines' Protection Society that are in the collection of Anti-Slavery International are compiled here, along with volumes in Rhodes House Library, Oxford. The publications reference numerous native tribes and include:

- The Aborigines of Australia
- The Maoris of New Zealand
- The Native American and Canadian Indians
- The Native South American Indians
- The tribes of Papua/New Guinea and other Melanesian, Polynesian and African tribes

Subjects include:

- The effects of colonization, slavery, forcible removal from ancestral lands, forcible land purchases and land-grabbing
- Religious practices and conversion
- The social state of the various tribes and their interactions with Europeans
- Leading personalities, including tribal chiefs and leaders

Included in the collection are the Annual Reports from 1839-1908; *The Aborigines' Friend* from 1847 to 1909 (originally known as *The Colonial Intelligencer*, or *Aborigines' Friend* and *Aborigines' Friend and the Colonial Intelligencer*) and a volume containing 32 of the Society's pamphlets from 1896-1908.

## The Beynon Manuscript

This classic microfilm collection represents the most extensive body of Tsimshian literature available for linguistic, anthropological and theological scholarship. It also provides documentation on North American Indian myths and traditions. The Tsimshian people are native to the territory along the international border between Alaska and British Columbia. They were cultural innovators who created the totem pole and many other art forms characteristic of the Pacific Northwest coastal region. The Beynon Manuscript was processed and transcribed by William Beynon, a native speaker of the Tsimshian language. He recorded the history, ethnography and literature of his people, preserving an important cultural history for the future. Included in the collection are:

- Narratives of clan histories and myths
- Descriptions of traditional ceremonies, practices and beliefs

In the mid-1930s, Beynon worked with the famed ethnologist and philologist Franz Boas, helping with precise translations of Tsimshian tales that Boas had recorded in phonetic orthography several decades earlier. Beynon added significant material and clarified passages that had been previously misinterpreted. Boas then indexed, abstracted and arranged into several volumes the more than 10,000 pages of The Beynon Manuscript. He presented the entire collection to Columbia University, where the original manuscript is now preserved in the Rare Book and Manuscript Division of Butler Library.

## **Bureau of American Ethnology Bulletins and Annual Reports, Smithsonian Institution**

1879 - 1971

The tribal cultures, history and heritage of Native Americans are of great interest today. Yet, primary sources for exploring these topics have been meager and widely scattered. This significant microfilm collection brings together essential research resources for the study of both North and South American Indians. Libraries that serve a Native-American population and institutions supporting research in American history, anthropology or Native-American studies will discover material on the prehistory, language, society and culture of many extinct tribal groups. The collection is divided into two sections:

- **Bulletins (V. 1-200, 1887-1971):** This segment contains articles, memoirs and monographs for probing such subjects as language, native arts and industries, institutions and organizations, myths and beliefs, ethnobotany, ethnogeography, physical anthropology and archaeology
- **Annual Reports (V. 1-48, 1879/1880-1930/1931):** The first 47 reports include administrative reports, ethnological papers and monographs covering all phases of aboriginal life plus numerous archaeological surveys. The 48<sup>th</sup> report includes an index to all preceding reports. Many of these valuable publications are now out of print.

While the bulk of material in this collection focuses on the history of Indian tribes within the United States, there is substantive information on the Indian tribes of Alaska, Hawaii, Mexico, Central America, Canada, Southern Yucatan and Northern Honduras. Many of the bulletins and reports also contain line drawings and photographic illustrations and an additional feature of the collection is a complete series of handbooks on South-American Indians. The collection reproduces an important series of documents of the United States Bureau of American Ethnology under the auspices of the Smithsonian Institution.

It is indispensable for general studies of North America in the colonial period and records manners, customs and traditions of the northern tribes of American Indians from a period for which there are few other records.

### **Dictionary of National Biography**

1885 - 1970

*'The Dictionary of National Biography is a gold mine, to be neglected at one's peril, for social scientists concerned with what used to be called real life but has been renamed qualitative social research.'*

A wealth of information about prominent British citizens, royal family members and politicians throughout history is now available on microfiche. Scholars of British history will find complete bibliographic information with ProQuest's edition of the Dictionary of National Biography. George Smith of the publishing company Smith, Elder & Co. founded the dictionary in 1882 with the resolve that it should "supply full, accurate and concise biographies of all noteworthy inhabitants of the British Isles and Colonies...from the earliest historical period to the present time." The first volume was published in 1885; the last volume of the dictionary, totaling 63 volumes, was completed in 1900. The entire dictionary was reprinted into 22 volumes at a later date, covering over 30,000 people, many of them important to American and Canadian colonial history as well as to British history. Seven supplements update the collection to 1970, covering another 6,000 biographies. ProQuest presents this 22-volume version plus the supplements on microfiche. Researchers can find personal facts on such people as George Abbot (1562-1633), Archbishop of Canterbury, a supporter of the Puritans and one who received great academic fame for his preaching. Coverage goes as far back as the year 735, when Alcuin, a theologian and an assistant to Charlemagne in educational reforms, was born. Here is a sampling of biographies included:

- **Matilda** (d. 1083) - queen of William the Conqueror, daughter of Baldwin V of Flanders
- **Odo** (d. 1097) - bishop of Bayeux, earl of Kent and half-brother of William the Conqueror
- **Owen Tudor** (d. 1461) - grandfather of Henry VII
- **Sir John Burgh** (1562-1594) - military and naval commander
- **Thomas Tudway** (d. 1726) - musician, composer and organist for Queen Anne
- **Dennis Delane** (d. 1750) - Irish actor, performed in Elizabethan drama
- **Sir William Howe Delancey** (d. 1815) - colonel, quartermaster-general's staff, killed in the battle of Waterloo

### **International Joint Commission (IJC) Reports on Water Quality in the Great Lakes**

1972 - 1982

In 1909, The International Joint Commission (IJC) - made up of three members from Canada and three from the U.S. - was established to address issues of air and water pollution, to regulate water flows and to investigate the rights, obligations and interests of either country along their common boundaries. In 1972, the U.S. and Canada signed the Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement which in turn established the Great Lakes Water Quality Board and Great Lakes Science Advisory Board - the principal advisory bodies to the IJC. Since then the functions of the IJC have grown to include a major commitment to maintaining and improving the water quality of the Great Lakes. Many subjects covered in this collection are technical in nature, but the reports are written so that the technical terms are easily understood. These archives and studies cover topics of water quality such as: restoring the Great Lakes ecosystem; contaminated sediments; nitrification and phosphorus management, toxic substances; urban, industrial and municipal run-off; atmospheric deposition; surveillance and monitoring; and human health effects from toxic substances in the Great Lakes. The microfiche collection contains over 221 titles which include:

- Reports, studies and special investigations from its sub-units - the Great Lakes Water Quality Board, the Science Advisory Board, the Reference Groups on Upper Lakes Pollution and the International Reference Groups on Great Lakes Pollution from Land Use Activities (PLUARG)

- Special task force and subcommittee reports, workshop and symposia presentations sponsored by the IJC, product guidelines and water quality regulations

## Manuscript Maps Relating to North America and the West Indies in British Repositories\*

1760 - 1783

The years 1760-1783 mark the apogee of British mapping in North America. Maps and plans at various scales were accepted as indispensable adjuncts to both the civil functions of colonial administration and to military needs for fortification, strategic planning and troop movement. Many of the maps surviving these decades were commissioned by the Crown and not only exemplify the development of cartography during the Enlightenment, but also provide a record, sometimes unique, of the events and places to which they relate.

## History

### American Papers in the House of Lords Record Office\*

1621 - 1917

For the history of the American colonies and the USA, the documents in the House of Lords Record Office, London, are an indispensable resource. Since the Jamestown settlement, material relating to North America has accumulated in the House of Lords Record Office, which serves as the record office for Parliament. The "Main Papers", i.e. the papers laid on the Table of the House of Lords have been thoroughly combed for American material for the first time and the resulting collection of material illustrates many aspects of the development of North America including immigration, settlement, trade (notably the slave trade), religion, fisheries, the railways, labor, patents etc. as well as politics and international relations.

The microfilm contains, where appropriate, material relating to Canada and the West Indies as well as the 13 colonies which became the United States of America. The microfilm is accompanied by a comprehensive printed guide consisting of a Calendar of the American Papers in the House of Lords Record Office and an Index to the microfilmed items in the Calendar. Because of its comprehensiveness, this volume clearly supersedes Andrews & Davenport, Paullin & Paxson, Crick & Alman and the other partial listings of American material in the House of Lords Record Office.

## Black Abolitionist Papers

1830 - 1865

Long neglected in studies of the anti-slavery movement that precipitated the Civil War, the important writings, speeches and correspondence of black abolitionists are drawn together in a comprehensive collection for researchers. Now libraries can supplement their African-American studies holdings with primary sources necessary for a complete study of this major historical topic. The collection encompasses approximately 15,000 articles and documents of nearly 300 black abolitionists in the United States, Canada, England, Scotland, Ireland, France and Germany and includes:

- The correspondence of key African-American leaders
- Speeches, sermons and lectures
- Articles, essays, editorials and other major writings from more than 200 African-American abolitionist and reform newspapers
- Receipts, poems and other miscellaneous documents

The Black Abolitionist Papers project was conceived, compiled and edited by George E. Carter, University of Wisconsin-LaCrosse and C. Peter Ripley, Florida State University, who recognized that these reformers were a persuasive force in the 19<sup>th</sup> century anti-slavery movement who had been virtually ignored. Among research topics to be explored in this collection are:

- Northern/Southern separatism within the church
- Black colonization and emigration
- Black political action
- Church support of black educational institutions
- Black intellectual and social life

This collection constitutes the largest single collection of materials touching antebellum African Americans. A black studies program would not be complete without access to these documents outlining the integral role played by African Americans in the anti-slavery crusade.

The Gerritsen Collection of Women's History provides an entire international library spanning four centuries and documenting the lives and experiences of women in the public and private arenas. ## Oddfellows Friendly Society Records\*

1829 - 1950

Friendly societies are mutual aid organizations designed to help people protect themselves against hardship. They were seen as a solution to the problems people knew they (or their families) would face should they fall ill or die leaving their children or spouse with limited resources. The friendly societies movement grew as new towns and industries developed in the 19<sup>th</sup> century and people found it difficult to rely on village communities. In the 20<sup>th</sup> century, state welfare provision in the UK improved. This rich collection reproduces the Magazines and Directories of one of the UK's largest Friendly Society. The quarterly Magazine, first published in 1828 was available free to each member. The Magazine was an informal publication aimed at keeping members informed of the activities of branches around the world and also used as a forum to exchange opinions between branch members. Fronted by a comprehensive contents page, each edition included:

Only English editions of the reports have been filmed and from 1975, departmental annual reports appear in *Microlog* and are indexed in the Canadian Research Index. We also film Departmental Reports submitted to legislatures as Budgets and Estimates. Recently, some Federal Departments and Agencies have omitted publishing a separate Annual Report because the information is already included in Departmental Estimates. Our files go back to the 1880s and are as current as the reports covering last year. In many cases, we have the complete files for Federal Departments. ## Canadian Treaties

1928 – Present

Micromedia ProQuest has collected on microfiche all treaties to which Canada has been a signatory power since 1928. Because of the irregular order in which treaties are issued, microfiche is the ideal medium for maintenance of backfile sets. Treaties since 1975 appear on discrete microfiche, so that updates may be interfiled as they appear. Treaties are published only after ratification, which can be some years after the cover date. The date represents the date the treaty was in force in Canada. Indexes are compiled and published several years later, therefore they are number one in each additional set. All treaties are bilingual.

Its objective was to fulfill the C.P.A.'s requirement for a serious and totally objective source of information on current world events. Perhaps the most valuable aspect of this microfilm reprint is that for the first thirty years or so of its existence the Report on Foreign Affairs (as it was then called) was a "restricted publication" with circulation only permitted among members of the C.P.A. and its associates. It is thus a rarely found source of world history, whose importance is enhanced by its impartiality.
