1807 - 1949

In 1807 the Catholic Church founded an Apostolic Prefecture in Batavia, with the twin goals of bringing the faith to the inhabitants of the archipelago and providing pastoral care for the Catholics among the Dutch colonial population. The archive is particularly valuable in that it survived WWII intact and thus provides scholars with an uninterrupted century and a half of historical source materials.

Originally compiled for the internal use of the civil servants of the Ministry of the Colonies of the Netherlands, this register may be compared to a modern documentation journal. It provides access to everything from the secret archives of the Ministry, to selected Mail Reports, Consular Correspondence, selected statistics from the Statistical Archives, articles in scholarly journals on colonial subjects and learned books and conference proceedings in Dutch, English, French and German.

The East Timor Question*

1975 - 1996

Claiming the support of the East Timorese population, the Indonesian government invaded the former Portuguese colony in December 1975 and later incorporated it as a province of Indonesia. During the last two decades there has been continued East Timorese resistance against the Indonesian government because of persistent human rights violations and systematic neocolonization. Australian journalist Jill Jolliffe has amassed a personal archive on the East Timor problem, containing many rare and unique materials originating from Portuguese, Indonesian, Australian, British, American and other international sources. Most materials date from the last twenty years, but there is also material from the late 19th century as well as the 1940s, 1950s and 1960s. A fascinating collection for all South Asian history researchers.

1900 - 1995

Each year following monsoon season in Vietnam, a harvest of unexploded ordinance appears in the countryside: M79 grenade rounds, flechette bombs and other lethal remnants of the war years. Even casual exploration can be fatal. Yet year after year, Vietnamese peasants continue to farm their fields in hopes of bringing new life to a war-ravaged land. The historical record of U.S. involvement in the Vietnam War can be compared to the ground on which it was fought. In spite of years of study, the topic is still considered explosive. Policies and motives of participants on all sides of the war have been obscured by "revisionist histories" of every political and ideological hue. Facts are contested and subject to change when new information appears. With the introduction of The Echols Collection: Selections on the Vietnam War, ProQuest brings together multiple historical and national perspectives with an eye toward providing better understanding of the Vietnam conflict.

These economic surveys of foreign countries published under the aegis of the Board of Trade have a virtue rare in government publications - they are concise and to the point. Written by the Commercial Secretary in the British Embassy or Consulate in the country in question, each report provides a narrative account of the country's economic, financial and trading situation backed by tables of detailed statistics. The statistical information is of particular interest since much of it came from local government sources and was not necessarily published elsewhere.

Human Relations Area Files

Human Relations Area Files, Inc. (HRAF) is an internationally recognized organization in the field of cultural anthropology. Established as a not-for-profit membership consortium of universities, colleges and research institutions, HRAF's mission is to provide information that facilitates the cross-cultural study of human behavior, society and culture. HRAF grew out of work in the 1930s by behavioral scientists at the Yale University Institute of Human Relations who began development of a classification scheme for cultural information by subject. The Human Relations Area Files was incorporated in 1949 with Harvard University, the University of Oklahoma, the University of Pennsylvania, the University of Washington and Yale University as its founding members. These five were joined within the year by the University of Chicago, the University of North Carolina and the University of Southern California. Some 300 colleges, universities, libraries, museums and research institutions in the United States and 25 other countries are now Associate or Sponsoring Members.

HRAF is a financially independent research agency of Yale University in New Haven, Connecticut. Since World War II, the growing concern of students, scholars and the general public around the world to understand ethnic conflict, cultural diversity and global problems has generated a demand for educational and research programs emphasizing the worldwide, comparative study of human behavior and society. The development of cross-cultural and area studies requires an extensive body of readily available organized cultural information. Scattered among myriad journals, dissertations and fieldwork studies and across numerous disciplines, conventional sources of such information are often inaccessible, expensive and difficult to utilize effectively. The HRAF collections are specifically designed to lessen these barriers to cross-cultural research.

Only members of HRAF can acquire access to HRAF collections. Thus individuals or institutions (colleges, universities, public libraries, museums, high schools, etc.) must first become members of the HRAF consortium before they can acquire microfiche. All applicants must be approved by the Board of HRAF. However, virtually all applicants are accepted.

- **Selected Sample File Set**

HRAF has created the Selected Sample File Set (also known as the Probability Sample Files), a specially selected group of 60 representative cultures from around the world, to enable global comparative studies when an institution is not able to acquire the complete collection. The materials in these files touch upon virtually all of the areas of social and cultural life of most interest to scholars and students. Each of the cultures in the Sample Set represents a different cultural area.

Images of East and West: Maps, Plans, Views and Drawings from Dutch Colonial Archives*

1583 - 1963

At the end of the 16th century, Dutch seafarers and merchants burst onto the world stage with commercial and military operations that took them to the far corners of the globe. Within a relatively short time, the tiny country on the North Sea had acquired a far-flung "seaborne empire" extending from the coasts of Western and South Africa to the Persian Gulf, South Asia and the islands of the Indonesian archipelago. The founding of the United Dutch East India Company (VOC) in 1602 was pivotal to this effort. From the beginning, the VOC realized the importance of accurate maps and plans of the areas under their control and the sea and coastal routes that gave access to these territories.

Index to Colonial Subjects in Dutch Newspapers*

1843 - 1947

Like its counterpart below, this index in handwritten form was compiled by civil servants of the former Ministry of the Colonies of The Netherlands for the use of the Minister and his staff. Only one copy exists. From over 40 Dutch newspapers the articles on colonial subjects were selected and indexed, mainly concerning the Dutch East and West Indies, but also concerning other colonial powers and Asian nations. The index was kept annually and in this micropublication each year starts on a new microfiche, containing the key words from A-Z for that year. These alphabetically-ordered key words (in Dutch) are geographical names, personal names and subject terms and they refer to one-line descriptions of the contents of an article in a newspaper, with the date of publication.

Labor Issues in Indonesia: Press Clippings and Other Documentation from the INDOC Archives *

1979 - 1995

INDOC was set up in 1979 as a nonprofit foundation to gather and disseminate contemporary information on issues of social development and human rights in Indonesia. Labor was one of the subjects on which INDOC regularly collected information - particularly in areas such as: labor policy and employment, wages, working and living conditions, collective labor agreements, employers' organizations, labor disputes, strikes, women and migrant workers and child labor. This collection consists of INDOC's labor clippings file, arranged in chronological order, with further divisions by subthemes.

1869 - 1940

With the opening of the Suez Canal, regular and reliable postal service between the East Indies and The Netherlands was available for the first time. These mail reports permit the study of colonial events in their continuity, unlike the Memories van Overgave which were snapshots of the situation at a particular point in time.

1849 - 1962

Starting in 1849, the government of The Netherlands ordered all of their civil servants leaving office in the East Indies Colony to write a memorandum of conveyance for their successors, containing a careful review of political developments in the district concerned and also giving background details on places, persons and issues important for the successor to know about. This has served as an important reference source for historians and other students of Indonesia in the colonial period.
